The Queen's Chain regulation, stating that all land within 20 metres of the shoreline is owned by the government and can be leased only, does not apply.

Other amenities which make St. Lucia such a popular vacation destination are the island's luxuriant rainforest, the nearby St. Lucia Country Club, the famous Gros and Petit Piton mountains (a World Heritage Site) and shopping and dining in the village of Rodney Bay, a 10 minute drive from the resort.
